

Introduction

Waste Recycling Group (WRG) is bringing forward proposals for new recycling and energy recovery facilities at Salt End for rubbish produced in the Hull and East Riding area.

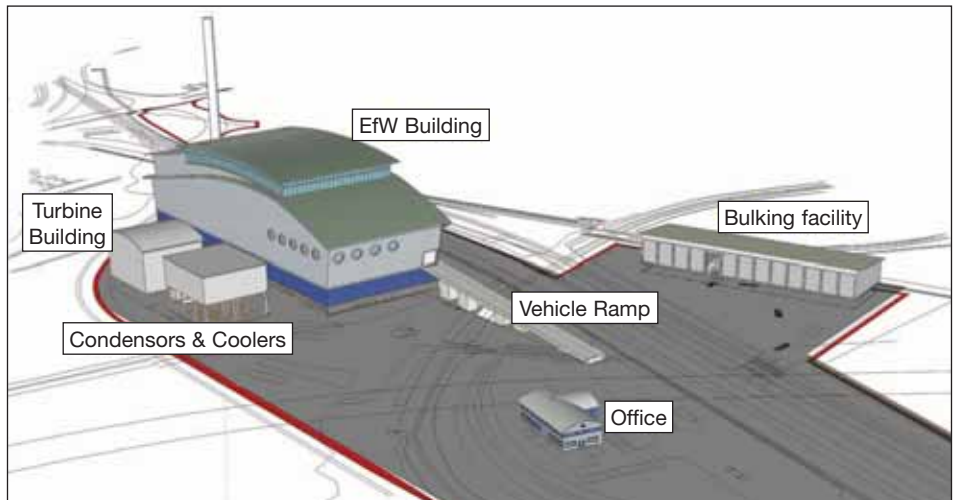
WRG will shortly submit planning applications to Hull City Council and East Riding of Yorkshire Council and will be holding public exhibitions to update local people on the proposals and what happens next. More details on the exhibitions can be found on the back cover.

Target 45+

Hull and East Riding's solution to sustainable waste management

Target 45+ will provide new facilities to increase recycling and composting in Hull and the East Riding to 45%. Waste which is not recycled will be converted into green energy, providing the energy equivalent to the energy needs of 31,148 households.

Target 45+ will save 4 million tonnes of waste from going to landfill in the next 20 years.



The new facilities

WRG is bringing forward new proposals for an Energy from Waste and recycling facility on vacant industrial land at Salt End.

Recycling

A facility is proposed to collect together up to 38,000 tonnes a year of paper, glass and metal separated by householders at home and collected by the councils through kerbside recycling schemes. This will be sent on for further reprocessing and will eventually be used to make recycled products.

Energy Recovery

Rubbish which has not been recycled will be used to generate electricity, through proven Energy from Waste technology. This technology is already used throughout the UK and Europe. The Energy from Waste facility (which some people call an incinerator) will recover energy from up to 240,000 tonnes a year of rubbish left after recycling.
