The Planning Application was submitted on 6 August 2007. Waste Recycling Group Limited submitted an appeal, following the non-determination by the Nottingham City Council of the Planning Application, on 17 December 2007. The application is currently before the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government on appeal (Reference APP/Q3060/A/08/2063129/NWF).

We give notice that Waste Recycling Group Limited submitted to Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government on 8 May 2008 Other Information in relation to the Environmental Statement in support of the Planning Application.

The Other Information consists of:

- (a) Additional material in respect of the need and alternatives to the Development;
- (b) Updated data in respect of the existing traffic movements at the Eastcroft Energy from Waste Facility and expected traffic movements arising from the Development; and
- (c) Updated data in respect of air quality and noise as a result of changes to the traffic data.
