Appeal by Waste Recycling Group Ltd

Relating to the application to Nottingham City Council

FOR NEW EXTERNAL TREATMENT TO THE EXISTING ENERGY FROM WASTE FACILITY TOGETHER WITH ITS EXTENSION TO CREATE 100,000 TONNES PER ANNUM ADDITIONAL CAPACITY FOR NON-HAZARDOUS WASTE TREATMENT, COMPRISING: NEW ARCHITECTURAL CLADDING TREATMENT TO THE EXISTING MAIN BUILDING AND COLOUR TREATMENT TO THE CHIMNEY STACK; LOUVRE; AND MESH SCREENS AROUND THE EXISTING FLUE GAS TREATMENT AND RESIDUE STORAGE FACILITIES; EXTENSION OF THE EXISTING BUILDING TO HOUSE A NEW BOILER AND GRATE AND A TURBINE HALL AND AIR CONDENSERS; ADDITIONAL FREE-STANDING FLUE GAS TREATMENT PLANT; A REPLACEMENT GATEHOUSE AND WEIGHT WEIGHBRIDGE OFFICE; AND NEW LANDSCAPE PLANTING.
